Gramothan Foundation is a community-driven nonprofit organization committed to uplifting marginalized rural communities in the remote forest-border regions of Karnataka, especially within the D.B. Kuppe Gram Panchayat of H.D. Kote Taluk. Established to bridge the development gap in underserved areas, the foundation focuses on four core areas: education, healthcare, rural development, and financial empowerment. With a dedicated team of educators, healthcare professionals, and development workers, Gramothan has reached over 6,000 individuals across 13 villages and tribal hadis, enabling access to quality learning, basic health services, sustainable livelihoods, and inclusive banking. Through grassroots engagement and collaboration with local institutions, the foundation is building a future where even the most remote communities can thrive with dignity and self-reliance.

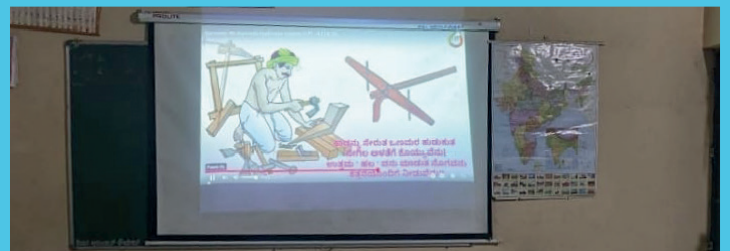

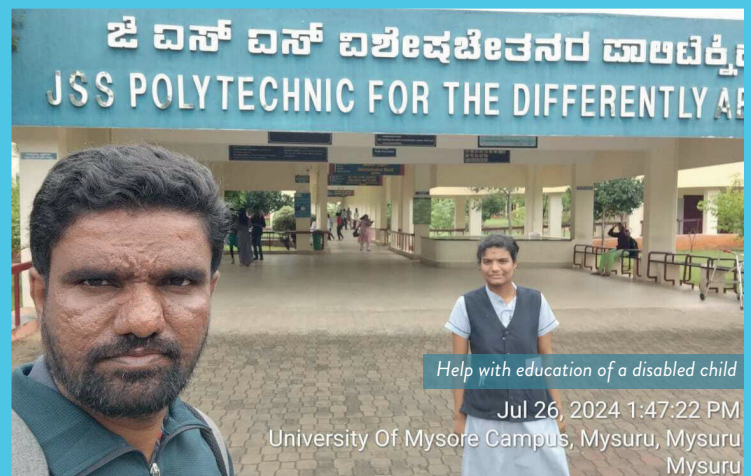

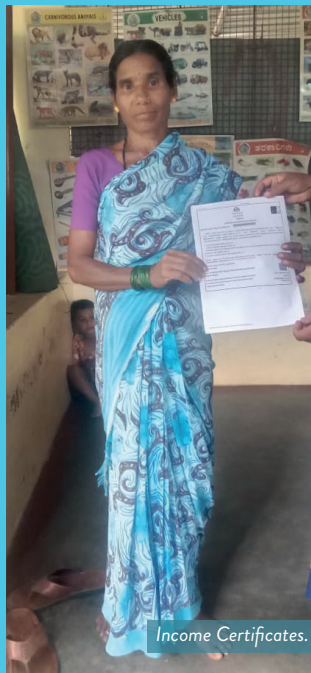
